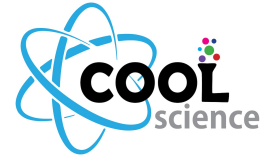


# COOL SCIENCE

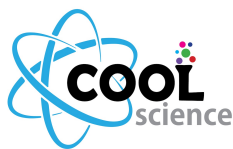
We have lots of rewarding opportunities for volunteers who enjoy sharing the wonders of science with kids:
